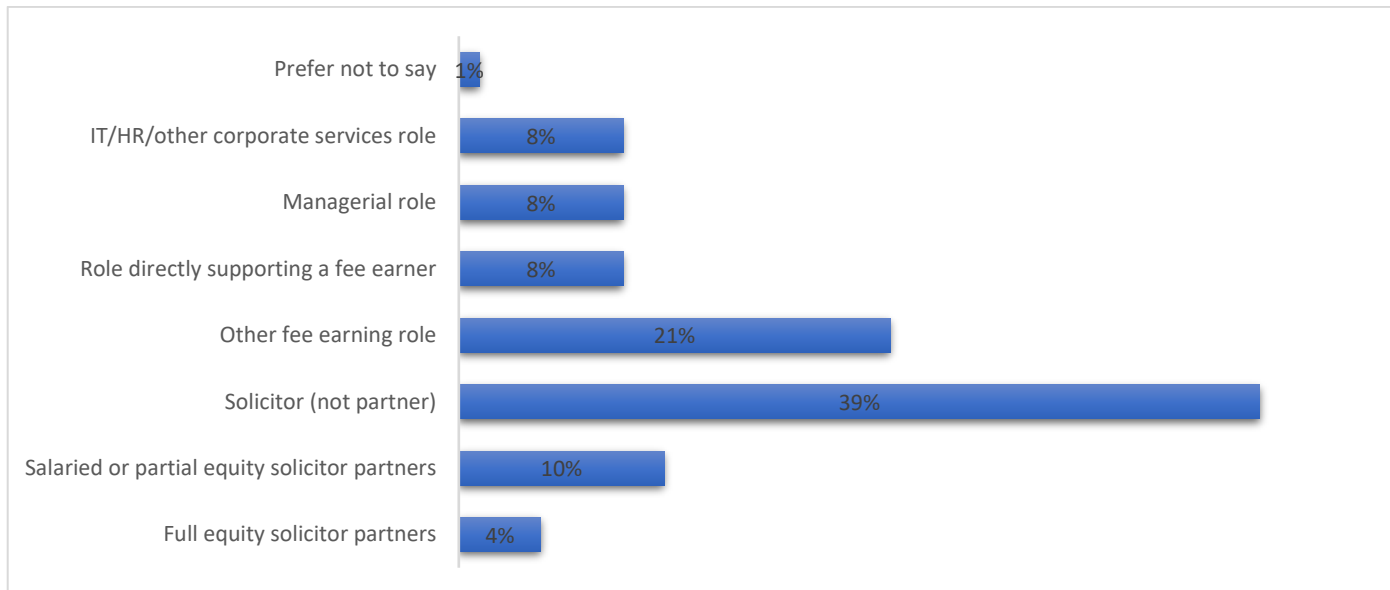
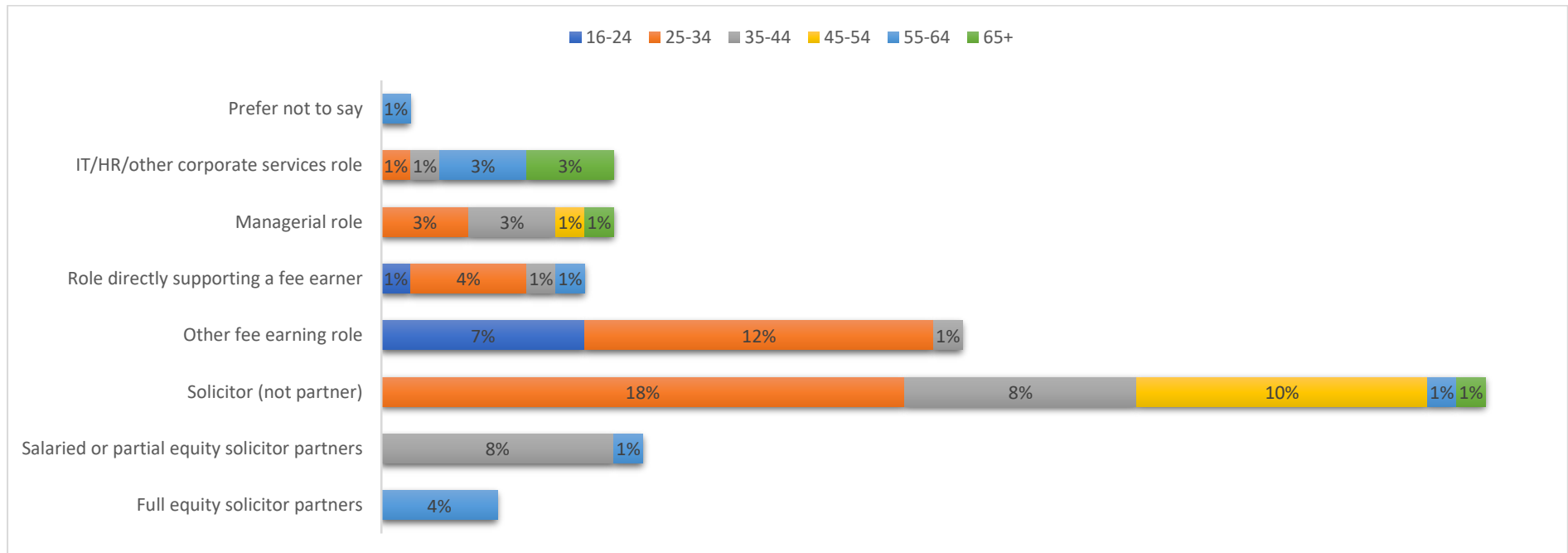

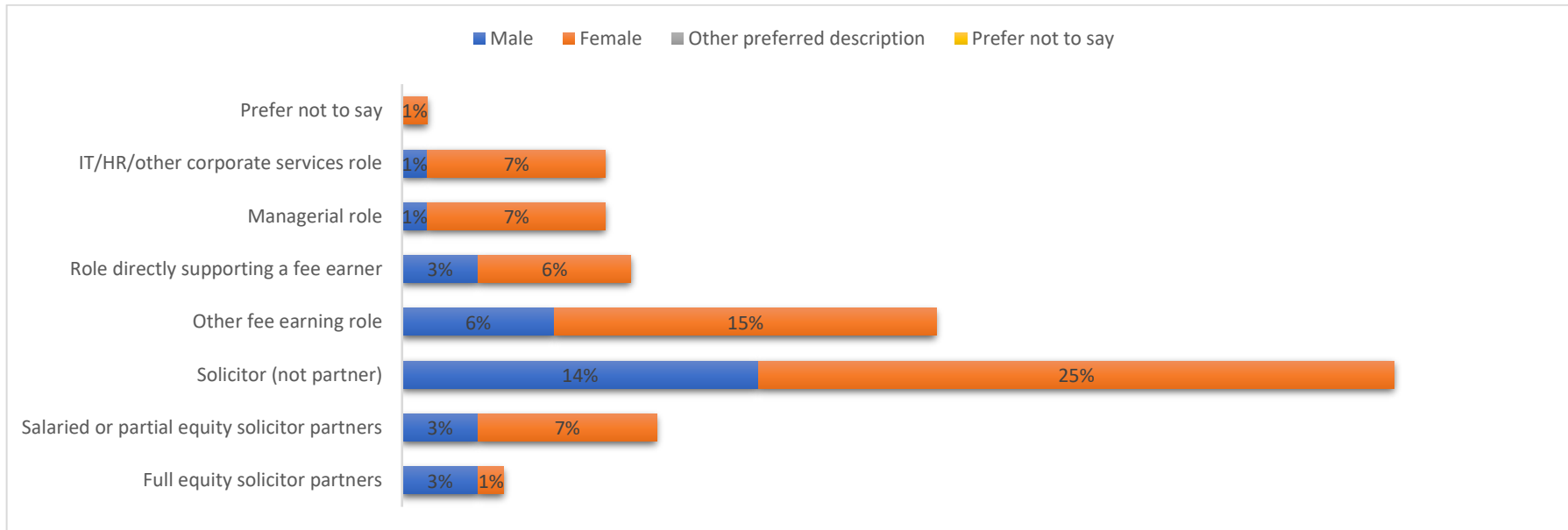
Question 1: Role Categories



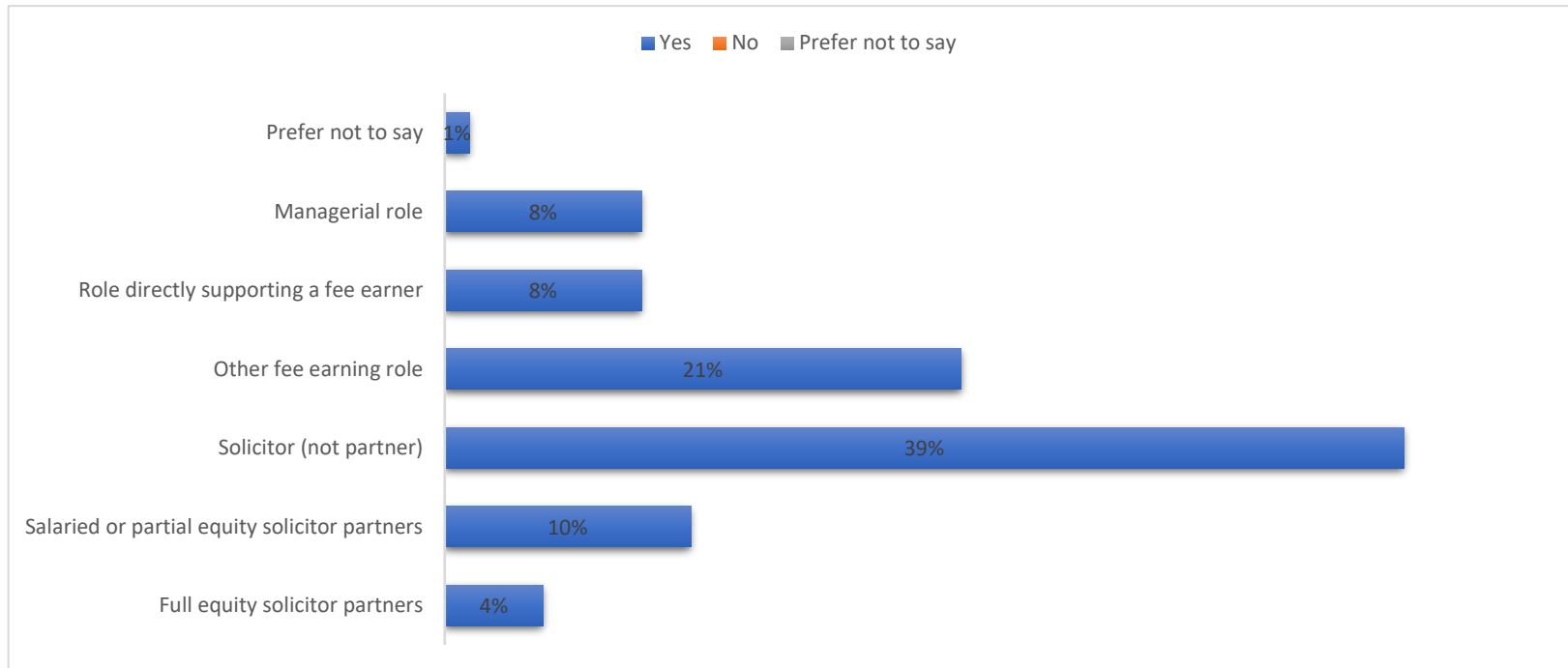
Question 2: Which age category are you in?



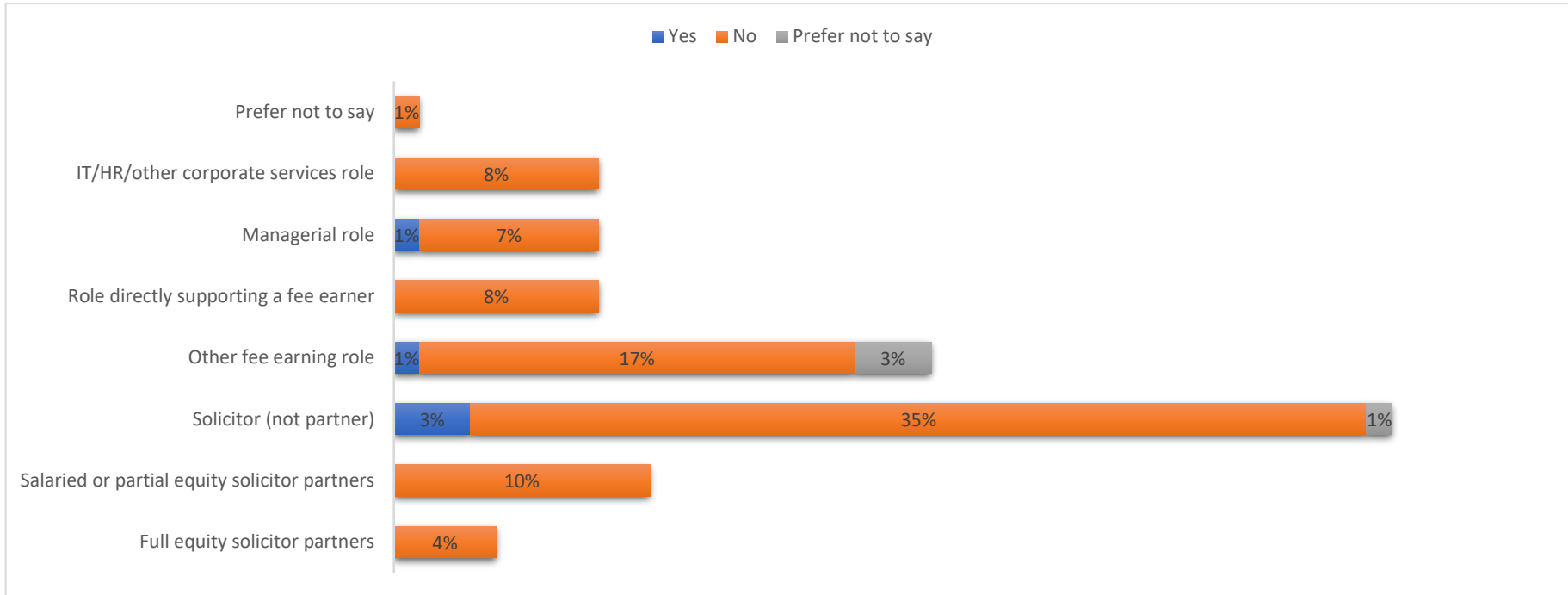
Question 3: What is your sex?



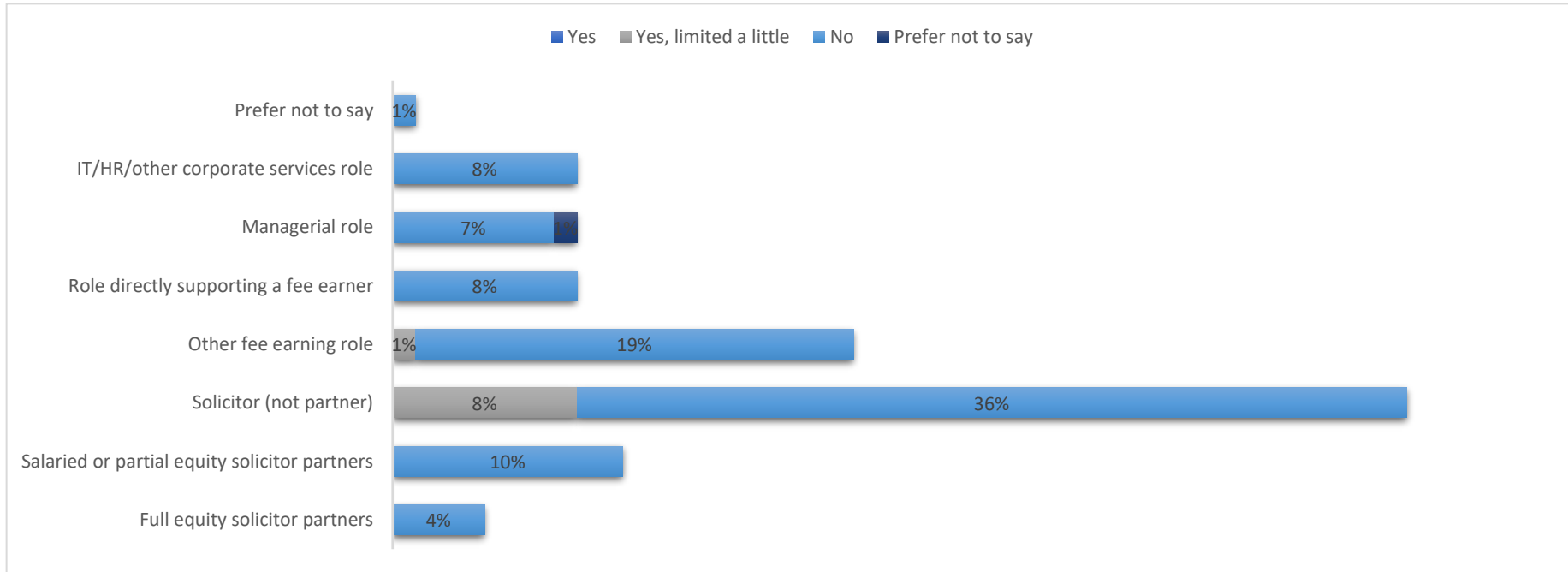
Question 4: Is the gender you identify with the same as your sex registered at birth?



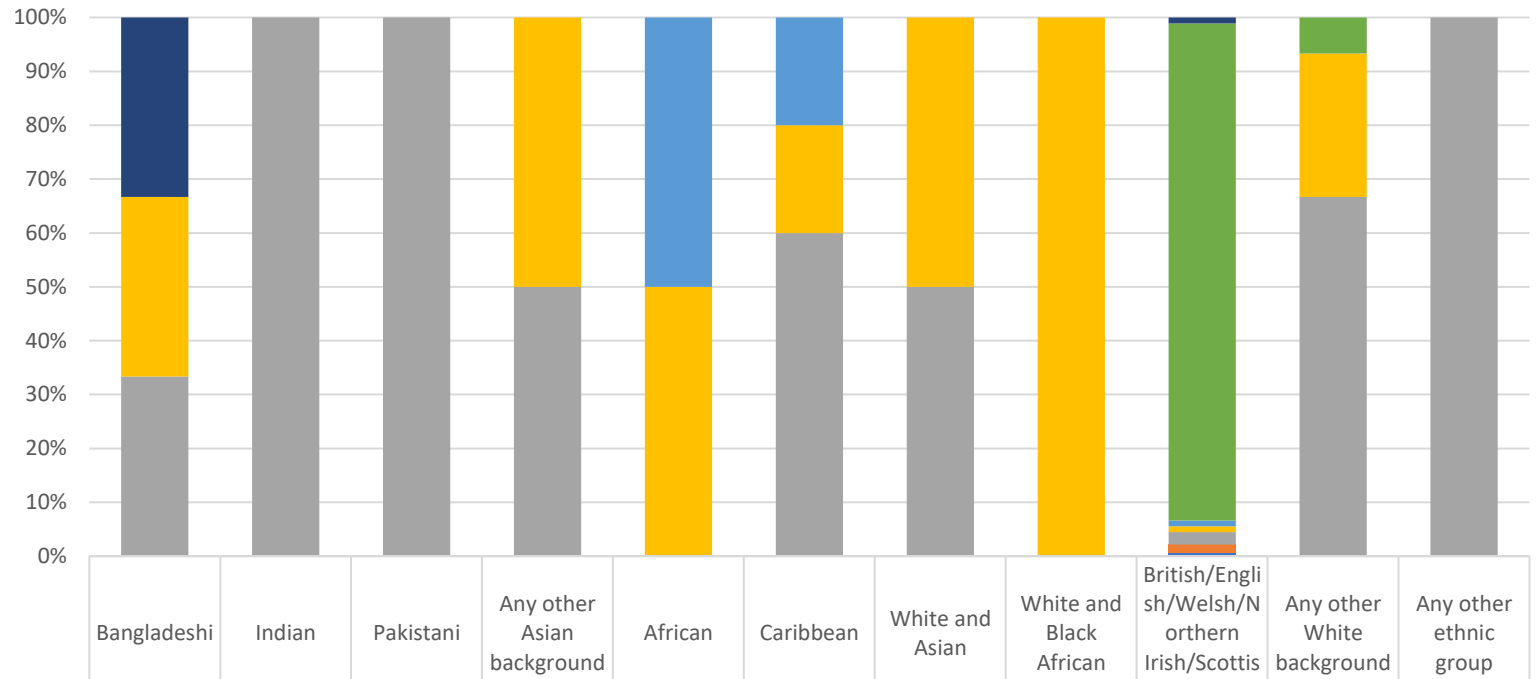
Question 5: Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act 2010?



Question 6: Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?

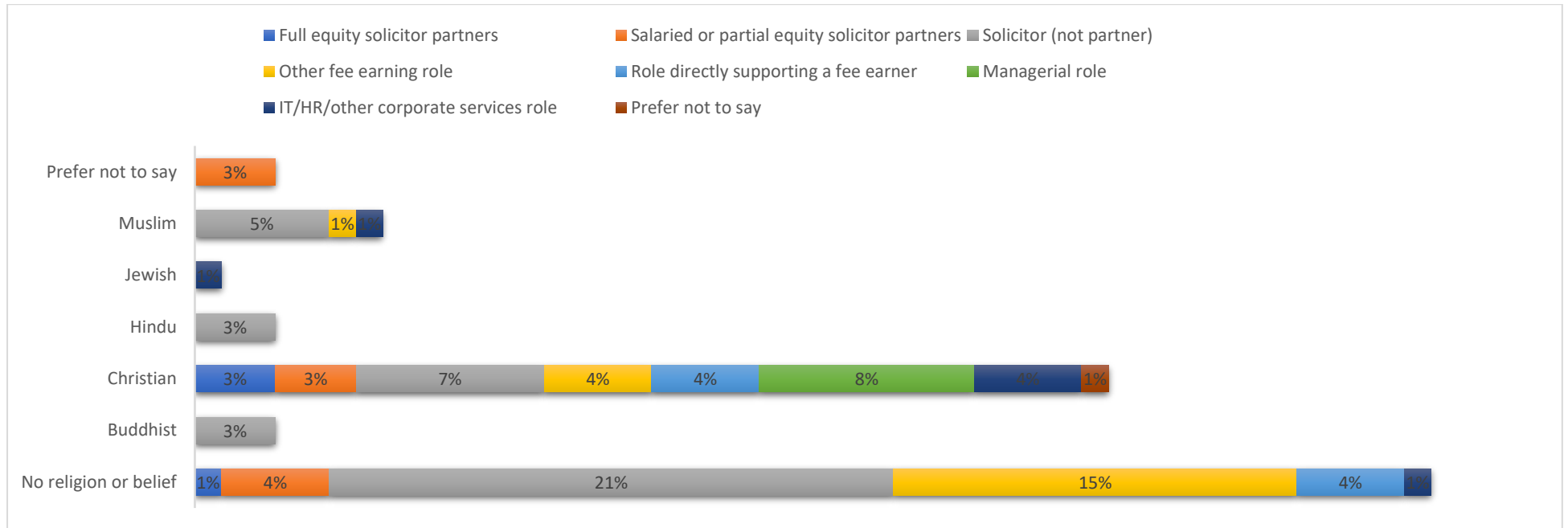

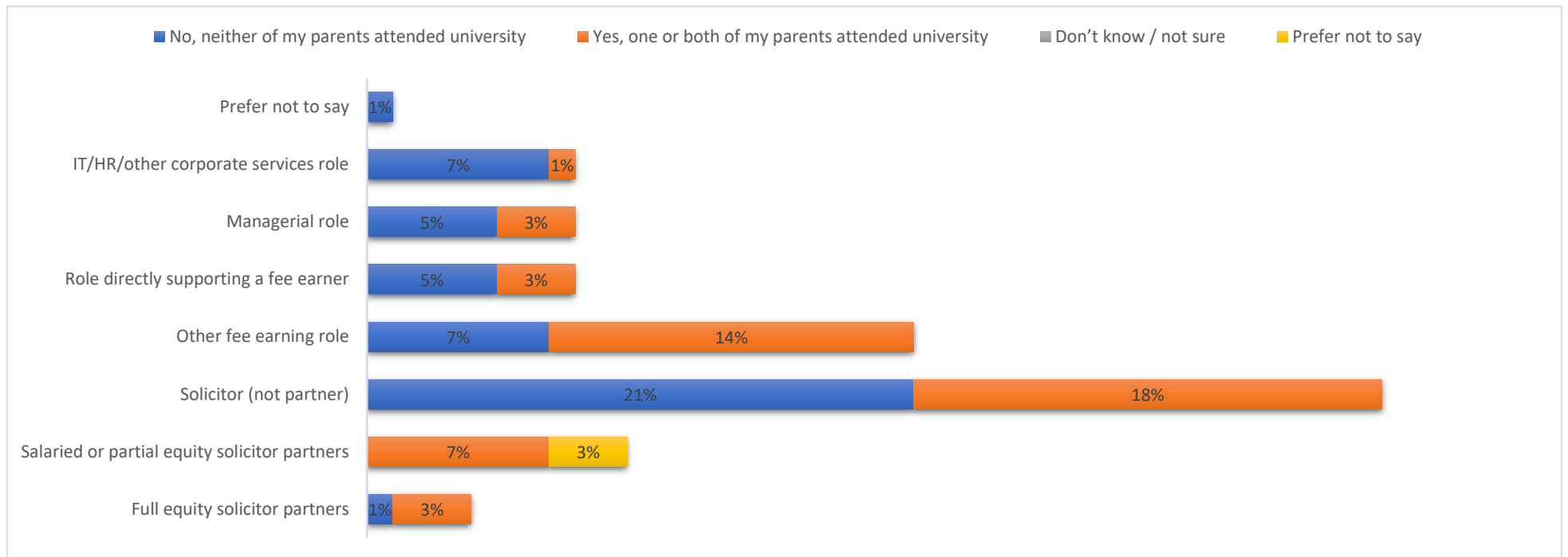
Question 9: What is your sexual orientation?



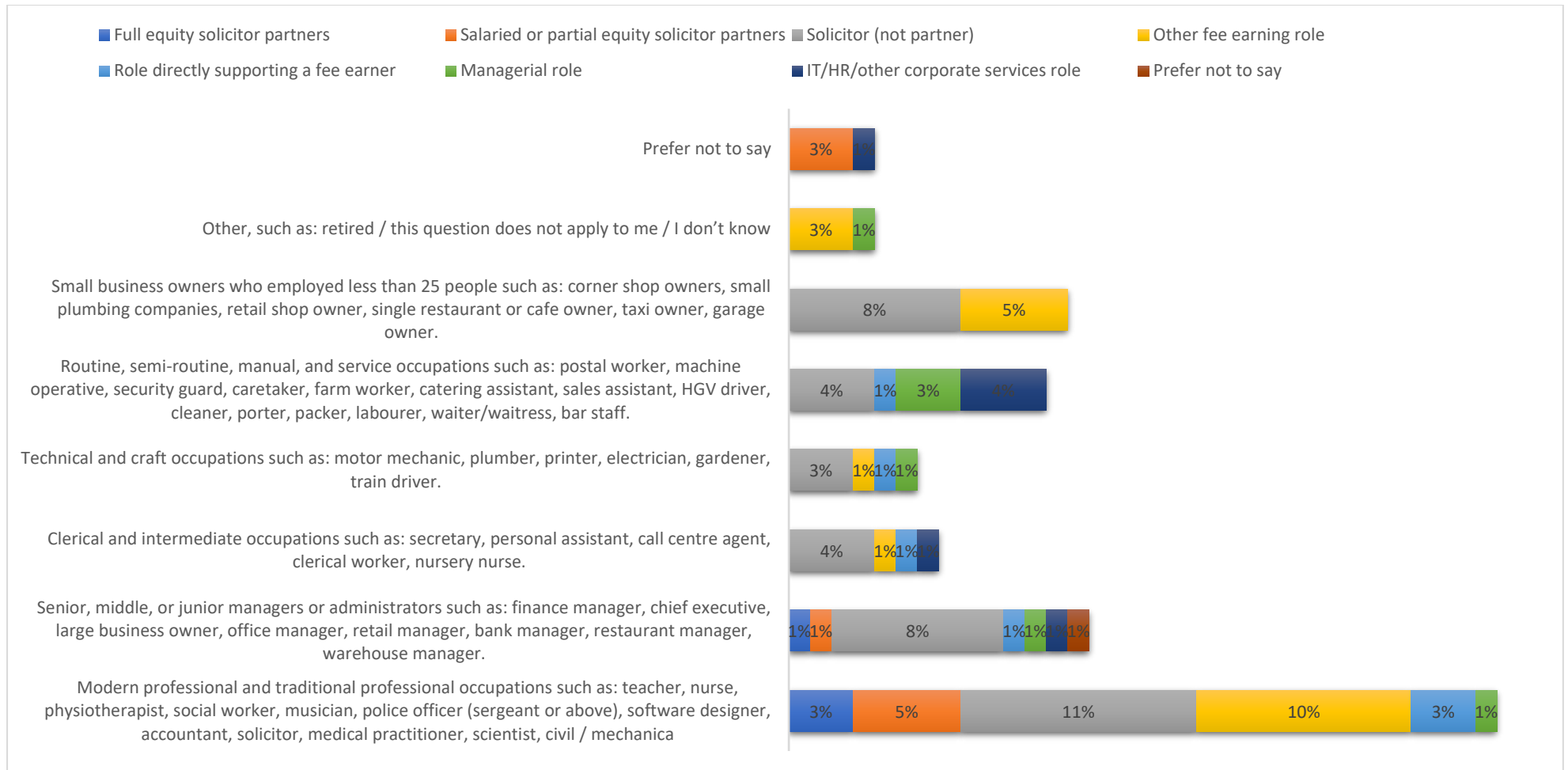
Question 10: Which type of school did you attend for the most time between the ages of 11 and 16?



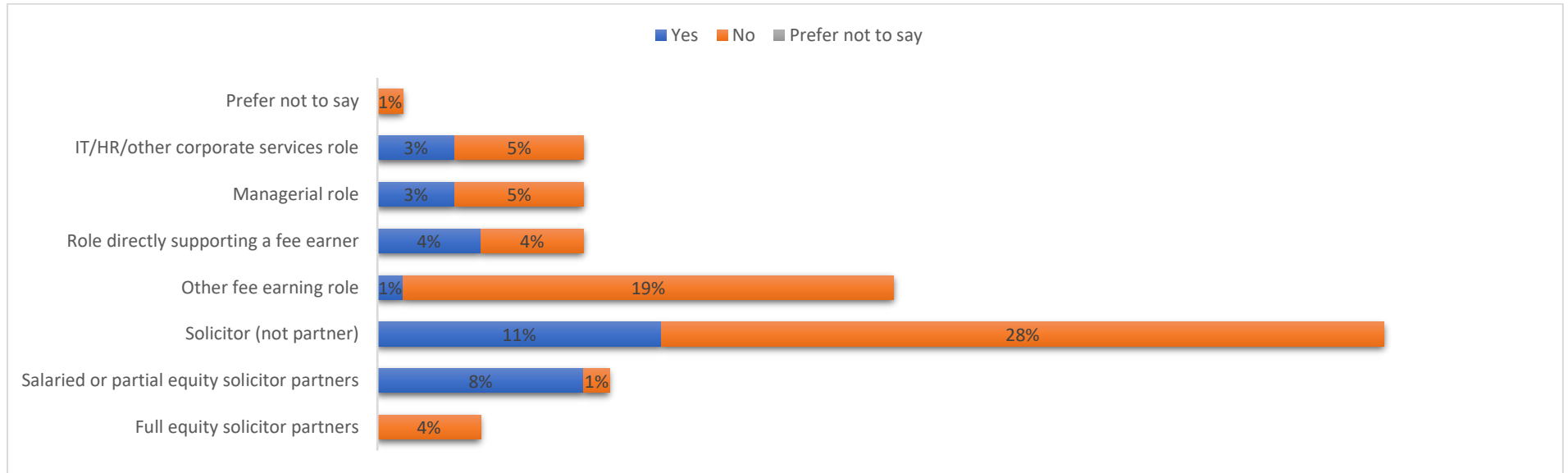
Question 11: Did either of your parents attend university and gain a degree (eg BA/BSc or equivalent) by the time you were 18?
